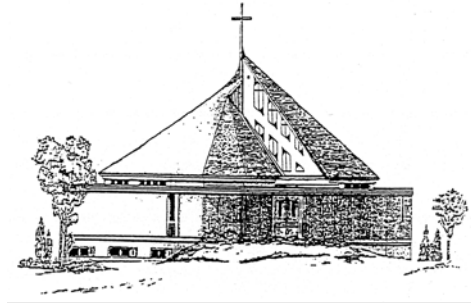

COLLECT USED POSTAGE STAMPS

Friends of the Leprosy Mission can help by sending them their trimmed, used postage stamps. The money realized from stamp sales is used to supply medicine, care and rehabilitation to people suffering from leprosy. Income from stamp sales to collectors has averaged \$10,000-12,000 per year! Dealers are interested in all stamps, but particularly in commemorative issues, foreign stamps and prefer that stamps be trimmed leaving ¼ - ½ inch border, not damaging the perforations. If you would like to help in this way, there is a labelled container on the missions board for your donations.
